


## Homework



# **Family Tree Update**

The on-line "Family Tree" currently resides at the **www.tjjfa.org/webtrees** website page using the **Webtrees** web application. Since genealogy data is generally considered private, a login is required to view the tree. A generic "cousin" login is available for simple tree viewing; the password for the "cousin" login is the same as communicated earlier, but, if you forgot it, send an email request to **webtrees@tjjfa.org** to get access and some navigation tips.

Since the last newsletter report we have added 54 individuals, 17 families and 14 new surnames to the tree. Some of the updates are from cousin updates, and the others from Internet discovery and obituaries. Unfortunately, Internet and obituary discovery is time consuming and often lacks the detail we would like in the tree (full names, event dates and locations)...so we much prefer the detail and accuracy that only the cousins can provide!

Cousins are encouraged to help with tree updates as their families grow and change. We continue to accept birth, marriage, divorce, and death information by email to the Webtrees administrator (webtrees@tjjfa.org) with a copy to the Secretary (secretary@tjjfa.org; be sure to include full names, event dates and locations to make the tree entries complete! If you send an email request for information, we can reply with some helpful descendant reports/charts from the tree (starting from, say, a grandparent) to show you where additions and updates are needed.

Due to the many (apparent) voids in the tree, there is still room for improvement! Maybe some of you would like to help research and fill in these branches. We currently only have three "Branch Genealogists" identified to assist with the **John Franklin**, **Mary Ann**, and **Robert Newton** branches...so it would be nice to get someone to volunteer for the other branches. Please email webtrees@tjjfa.org if you'd like to help.

In the **Celestia Louisa** branch John Jay LeFurgey's (Celestia's adopted son) death certificate clearly has the capital **F** so those LeFurgeys were corrected in the tree. The **John Franklin** branch Lefurgeys were left with the lowercase **f** based on Harry James' draft card signature. After a bit of research I have not been able to find the relationship between the Le?urgeys in the two branches. Any cousins in the **John Franklin** or **Celestia Louisa** branch have any insight on the relationship and name difference?

Trying to keep the tree growing is contingent on having as many Jones contacts as possible. We need to make sure that the younger generations are joining our Facebook group, and providing their email addresses, so we can keep them aware of their Jones heritage.

In the last newsletter we highlighted the three Frank W Wright kids (Judson, Claude and Myrtia) that married into the Jones family at the third generation of Joneses. If any cousins have interesting, Jones-related facts or stories to share with the group we'd be happy to publish them in a future newsletter...just email us a writeup.
