Meeting was adjourned at 1:44pm and Reunion Photo was taken.

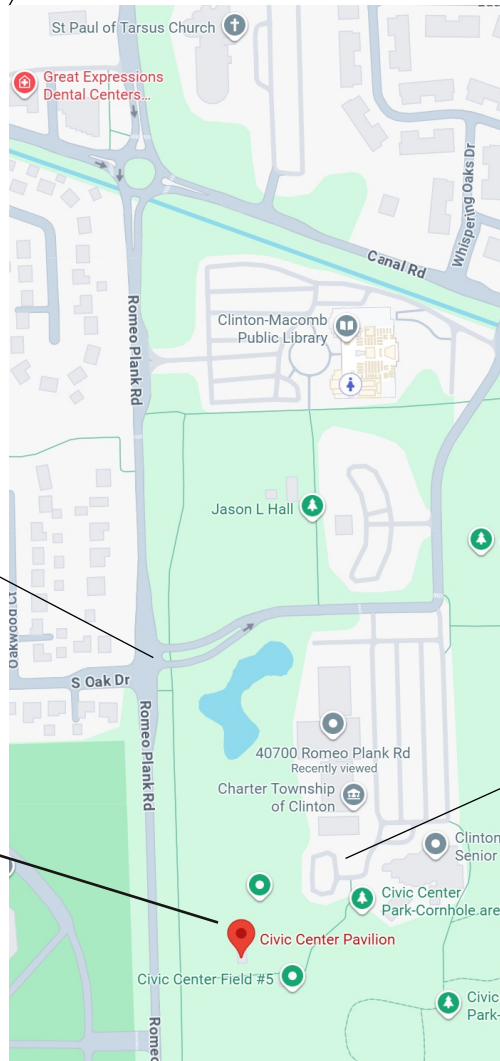
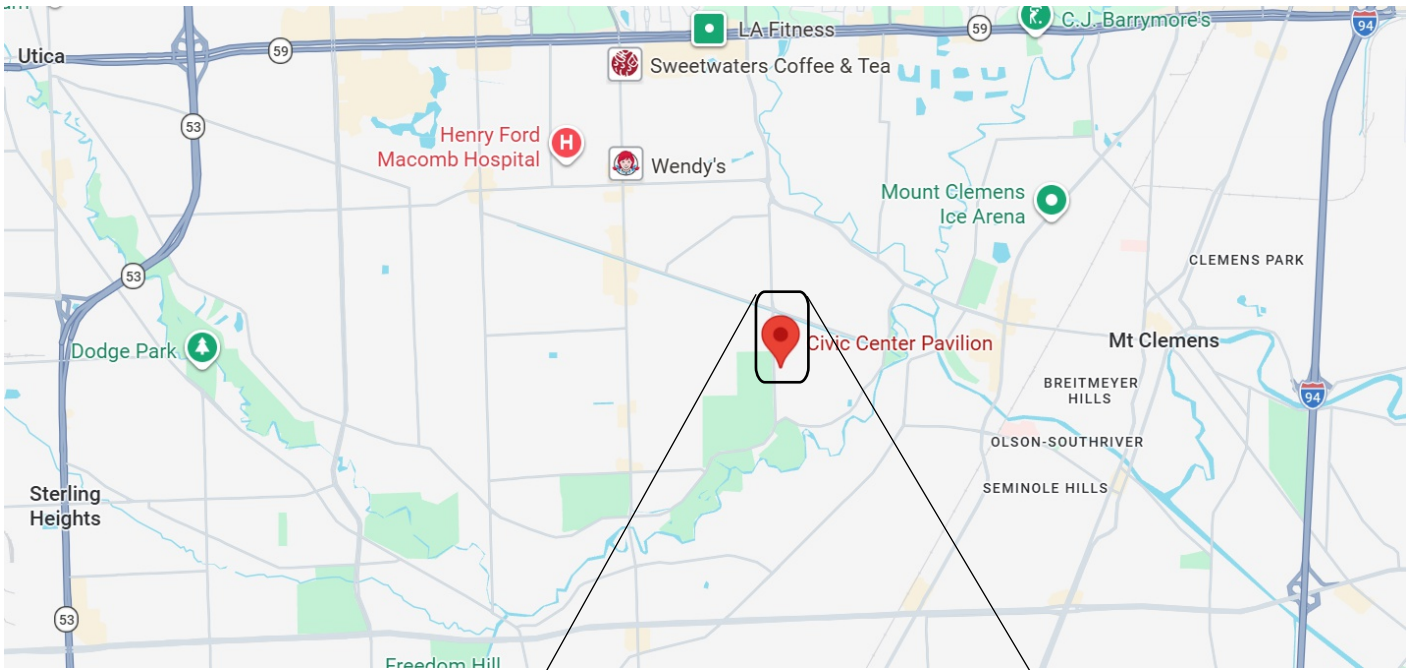

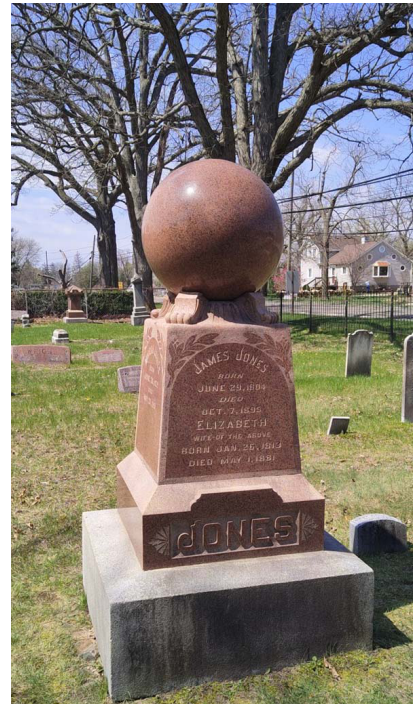

Has anyone noticed that the granite sphere on top of the James Jones monument in the Meade Cemetery was missing? It was moved many years ago due to vandalism. We had the sphere remounted and professionally secured by Lincoln Granite. Many thanks to the Robert cousins for helping to "get the ball rolling" on this project. The cost of the restoration was \$750. After using early donations (Robert and David cousins), most all of our current treasury funds, and some temporary personal credit, it is estimated that we still need an additional \$600 in donations to clear the credit and restore our treasury account to the minimum level (to avoid the bank fees.) 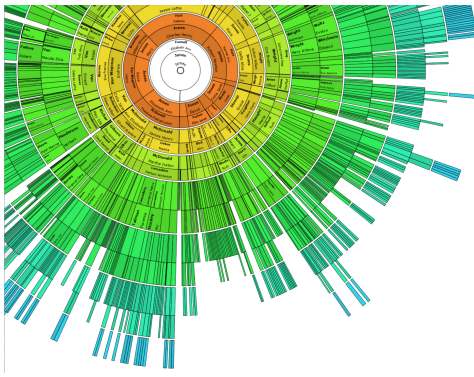
Grace and her daughters were very gracious in welcoming us into their home and even feeding us, as they shared the family history with us.

Family Tree Update

Since the last newsletter report we have added 86 individuals, 52 families and 40 new surnames to the family tree. Some of the updates are from cousin updates, and the others from Internet discovery and obituaries. Internet and obituary discovery is time consuming and often lacks the detail we would like in the tree (full names, event dates and locations)...so we much prefer the detail and accuracy that only the cousins can provide! We continue to accept birth, marriage, divorce, and death information by email to the Webtrees admin (webtrees@tjffa.org) with a copy to the Secretary

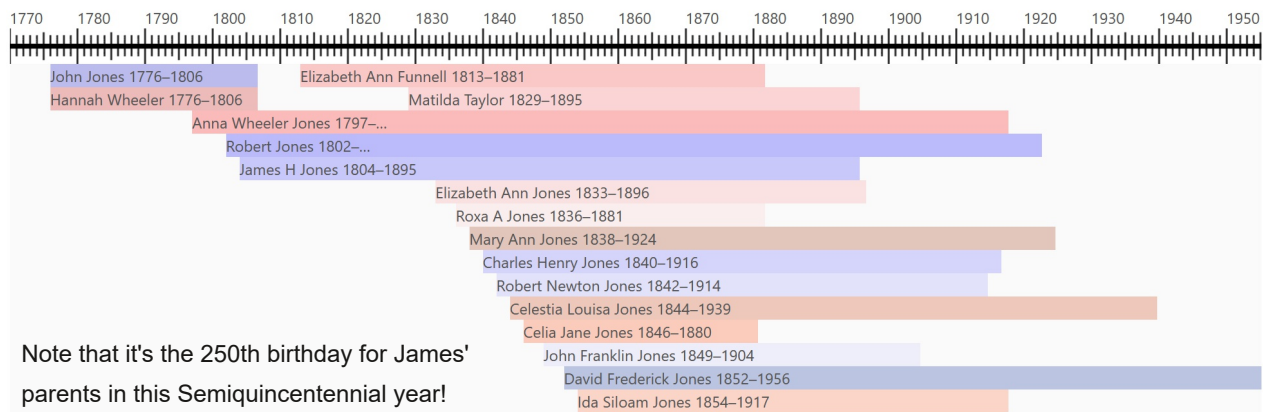
(secretary@tjffa.org); be sure to include full names, event dates and locations to make the tree entries complete. If you send an email request for information, we can reply with some helpful descendant reports/charts from the tree (starting from, say, a grandparent) to show you where additions and updates may be needed.

The on-line family can be accessed at www.tjffa.org/webtrees using a generic, "cousin" login for read-only viewing; the login/password is communicated by email, and, if you forgot it, just send an email request to webtrees@tjffa.org to get access.

Family Trees grow unbelievably fast since each new child creates a new branch. We currently have 10 children in the 9th generation and, in just a few years, they will be creating the 10th generation. Who knows how long we'll be able to manage this tree and keep it growing! Additionally, there are many individuals, marriages, and children still missing in the current tree. To grow the tree, we must also add descendants to our contacts list. We have correlated our contacts list with the tree database to show which branches are missing contacts, then we search the Internet and Facebook for them. Many Facebook IDs have been identified as Jones descendants but, unfortunately, only a couple have responded to all the Facebook messages that have been sent out. Those that do respond are extremely happy that we have reached out to them so they can know more about their Jones heritage. I'm currently in contact with a "forgotten" Charles branch which, apparently, has some male descendants that will carry on the original Jones surname...I think this is a big deal, as we only knew one such individual before.

Maybe some of you would like to help research and fill in these branches. We currently only have three "Branch Genealogists" identified to assist with the John Franklin, Mary Ann, and Robert Newton branches...so it would be nice to get someone to volunteer for the other branches.
